


Facts About Aging Out Of Foster Care

Of the 28,000 foster youth who aged out of foster care in 2010:

- 74% completed high school
- 70% planned to attend college
- 3 to 11% completed a bachelor's degree
- 52% were employed at age 21
- 22% were homeless for one day or more after leaving care
- 25% suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder



