The COVID Briefing has now transitioned to a weekly COMMUNITY CONNECTION and will continue to provide information of interest to the Fowler Family. We hope you will prioritize Tuesday at 2pm and tune in to Channel 6 as a time of connection, community, and communication.

- Good afternoon Fowler Family!
- COVID UPDATE:
 - Yesterday, Dallas County announced 407 new cases and 9 COVID related deaths
 - Friday, the governor announced that more than 20 million doses of the vaccine have been administered in Texas and <u>50%</u> of those eligible to receive the vaccine have received at least one dose.
 - Yesterday, the CDC announced that we have reached a landmark day 60% of Americans have received at least one dose of the vaccine.
 - Additionally, more than 4.1 million youth ages 14-17 have been vaccinated
 - 51% of people of color have been vaccinated, which is higher than the 40% of the general population that they represent.
 - This is all encouraging news which is initiating new protocols
 - The CDC also made a surprise announcement last week regarding mask wearing an announcement that surprised even the White House.
 - The CDC new recommendation states that vaccinated people can forego wearing a mask, both inside and outside, except in healthcare facilities.
 - What does that mean for us at Fowler?
 - In our licensed area, it means nothing. We are still governed by Health and Human Services and masks must remain in use in healthcare environments, which mean Pearl Nordan Center and FCA Assisted Living.
 - Jackson Living Center residents are 100% vaccinated we will no longer require you to wear a mask. It will be to your own discretion if you choose to wear a mask
 - JLC Teammates who are unvaccinated, you must wear a mask
 - In FCA independent living where we have not achieved 100% vaccination rates, if you are not vaccinated, we request that you wear a mask.
 - FCA Vaccinated residents, you will choose whether to wear a mask in public, however, if you are in the CD building, you must wear a mask on the elevator and on the first floor as the first floor is licensed to assisted living.
 - Residents and staff, continue to be mindful of those around you
 - Which friends and family members have not been vaccinated ask the questions, take responsibility for your safety and wear a mask around unvaccinated individuals and ask that they wear a mask around you

- While the vaccine is 95% effective, we do not know who will fall in the 5% that will contract a serious and possibly a deadly case of COVID
- We have experienced this in FCA
- Teammates, if you are unvaccinated, you must continue to wear a mask at all times – from the car when you arrive back to the car when you leave.
- Teammates, if you are vaccinated and you work in independent living or support services, you no longer need to wear a mask to and from your car or at work
 - If you enter a licensed area or come in contact with a resident from one of those areas, you must wear a mask so keep your masks with you
- If you are attending worship services in-person in the chapel, you must wear a mask – the chapel is in a licensed area
- We will continue to encourage Love Your Neighbor Basics in all environments, including the grocery store and other public spaces outside of Fowler
- <u>Regarding our visitors:</u>
 - In our licensed areas, masks remain
 - In our non-licensed areas, the responsibility is on the visitor and the resident to act responsibly
 - New signage will appear in JLC, FCA IL and The Ebby House that states that vaccinated individuals do not need to wear masks; unvaccinated are requested to wear one.

- The Support Services team is no longer staffed to make deliveries to other buildings in our community.
