• COVID UPDATE:

- Yesterday Dallas County reported 133 new cases.
- Health authorities are concerned about the rise in the numbers we had averaged 100 day for most of June...
- As you continue to venture out be aware of your surroundings and be proactive in confirming that the people you are with, are vaccinated.
 - We continue to recommend that if you are around someone who is not vaccinated, maintain a 6-foot distance and keep a mask with you.
 - Utilize our Love Your Neighbor Basics, which are basic infection control practices to protect yourself if necessary
 - Each of us is charged to protect ourselves as needed, which protects each other
- We remain firm in our belief that the best way to avoid COVID is to be vaccinated. If you wish to be vaccinated, we can assist you securing that for you here through our pharmacy partner
