- Good afternoon Fowler Family!
- COVID UPDATE:
 - o On July 2, Dallas County reported 154 new cases.
 - We had been averaging 100 in June, so this is a significant bump
 - All Dallas County residents (Both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated) are asked to help prevent spread of the virus by practicing these simple actions:
 - Avoid close contact with other people, especially those who are sick
 - Cover coughs and sneezes
 - Exercise hand hygiene
 - Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
 - If you are sick, stay home.
 - o For non-vaccinated people, you need to continue to do these things, plus wear a mask
 - A reminder: our team in PNCC is still wearing masks and if you enter PNCC, you must put on a mask for the entire time you are in the building
 - It is imperative that you wear your mask correctly
 - Over your nose and mouth always
 - Recently a family member traveled here to see their loved one, having not seen her mom for over a year, and she was met by two individuals who were not wearing their mask over their nose and mouth
 - In the words of this family member "this did not instill confidence in me that you are taking every precaution to care for my mom"
 - You only have one opportunity to make an impression this impression will stay with this family member and we have unnecessarily made this family member feel uneasy
 - If you are considering travel outside of the United States, check your destination before you book any travel
 - Current travel advisories can be viewed at the <u>U.S. Department of</u>
 <u>State</u> and <u>CDC</u>. The CDC recommends that travelers defer all <u>cruise</u> <u>travel</u> worldwide

• FOWLER UPDATES:

- Dallas Police reported last week that it has been taking up to 13 seconds to answer a
 911 call in the month of June
 - This is directly related to staffing shortages
 - Out of 110 call-takers, 26 positions are currently vacant
 - To resolve the issue, they have pulled staff from other areas temporarily
 - As a result, they have been able to return to an under 5 second response
 - We wanted to alert you in case you have a need to call 911 stay on the line, your call will be answered
- We received another complaint over the weekend about speeding employees in the neighboring streets
 - As a result, a neighbor in the adjacent neighborhood has requested speed enforcement from the Dallas police department
 - THE SPEED LIMIT ON THESE RESIDENTIAL STREETS IS 25 MILES PER HOUR treat these streets like a school zone
 - If you are stopped for a ticket and you are late clocking in, you will have a ticket to pay and you will have the consequences of being late to work
 - If you are speeding, you are not a positive representation of Fowler you are not living our values to love people, pursue excellence and make a difference
 - You are a reflection of JFC on and off our campus and it is critical that we are good neighbors
 - Managers, please make this a topic of your team meetings so that we can impact all employees – our night staff and our weekend staff does not have the benefit of hearing these briefings at this time and it is important that all of our team honors the speed limit
- We are aware that the elevator is down in the F building we are working with the repair company to get it fixed. We appreciate your patience.
