The COVID Briefing has now transitioned to a weekly COMMUNITY CONNECTION and will continue to provide information of interest to the Fowler Family. We hope you will prioritize Tuesday at 2pm and tune in to Channel 6 as a time of connection, community, and communication.

- Good afternoon Fowler Family!
- A few months ago, we transitioned our COVID Briefing to the Community Connection in hopes that we would be talking less about COVID and more about our community and the people who live and work at Fowler
- Unfortunately, that is no longer the case
- COVID UPDATE:
 - Yesterday Dallas County reported 870 new cases of COVID
 - It is anticipated that those numbers will climb to 1500 per day by mid-August
 - This rise in COVID is happening all over our country as the Delta variant surges
 - Nationally, new daily cases rose 54.2% over the past week, while deaths rose by 31.6% and hospitalizations by 42.2%
 - In Baton Rouge Louisiana, Dr. Catherine O'Neal, chief medical officer and infectious disease specialist at Our Lady of the Lake Hospital stated this week, "There are no beds left. These are the darkest days of this pandemic. We are no longer giving adequate care to these patients."
 - Texas and Florida lead the surge; Florida hit an all-time high of 11,515 hospitalizations
 - In Dallas, our positivity rate has gone above 10% which means non-vaccinated employees in PNCC will begin COVID testing 2x per week
 - The surge is a result of low vaccination rates
 - Breakthrough in vaccinations account for less than 1% of the surge
 - Those breakthroughs are expected it doesn't mean the vaccine doesn't work
 - Throughout Texas, healthcare systems are mandating vaccines for their employees and affiliations
 - How that impacts us remains to be seen but it is imperative that we continue to be recognized as a healthcare partner for Baylor Scott and White, Methodist Health System and Texas Health Resources who have all mandated vaccines
 - o At Fowler, we have a high rate of vaccinated employees
 - We are proud of our team members and residents who put the needs of others above their own fears or preferences
 - This is truly the ultimate Love Your Neighbor Basic!
 - There are several memes floating around Facebook about the eradication of polio, measles, and smallpox, etc

- These were all diseases of the past not because we reached 'herd immunity' and they ended; but because our population understood sacrifice and commitment to the greater community, and they became vaccinated
- Many of you will remember receiving the polio vaccine
 - Those who lived in Dallas in 1962, will remember lining up at a school or rec center to get their sugar cube polio vaccine it is amazing to think that over 700,000 people were vaccinated in 3 days in August of 1962 without a fuss
- The time has come for everyone to step up, without a fuss, and get a COVID vaccine
- We recognize that there are a rare few who have a medical or religious exemption
 - We are defining those exemptions and going forward as you state your exemption, it will be documented and placed in your employment file
 - All new hires will be required to provide vaccination proof
- We remain steadfast in our goal to be 100% vaccinated
 - It is our desire to achieve this goal by choice it is our culture it is the Fowler way
 - We should be 100% vaccinated because it's the right thing to do not because it is mandated
 - For those of you who are sitting on the fence, its time to move forward and be vaccinated
 - I am personally asking you to take this step for the health and wellbeing of yourself, your family, and our residents
- I also want to remind everyone about the proper way to wear a mask over your nose and mouth

• FOWLER UPDATES:

- Last week, the winners of the DCEO Nonprofit and Corporate Citizenship Awards were announced – there were more than 500 nominations
 - Fowler was a finalist in the COVID Resiliency category
 - We did not win; however, we were thrilled to be recognized
- Fowler has been approached by a research team at University of Texas in Arlington to participate in a Senior Fit Program
 - We are looking for individuals to participate in this 9–12-month study
 - The study has been funded by the Communities Foundation of Texas
 - Flyers have been distributed at FCA and Jackson Living Center
 - You may participate if you:
 - Are 65+
 - Have an annual household income less than \$75,000
 - Have a smart phone and wi-fi access
 - Able to walk at least ¼ mile
 - Participants will receive a Walmart gift card for each month they participate
 - If you are interested in participating, please reach out to your manager and we will get you in touch with our friends at UTA

- The irrigation assessment has been completed and we have approved all the recommended repairs and expansion to the system. This work will begin in mid-September.
- We have had some challenges with our phone system which has also impacted our ability to respond to callers at the gates.
 - To resolve these problems, we will be doing a complete reboot of the system tonight, August 3, at 8pm
 - The entire phone system, including response at the gates, will be down for 15 minutes
 - Thank you for your patience during this time
- This Saturday is the BvB football game at 7pm at the Cotton Bowl
 - BvB Dallas is a group of young professionals who come together annually to raise money in the cause against Alzheimer's – they play a flag football game at the Cotton Bowl – it's the Blondes versus the Brunettes!
 - To date, BvB Dallas has raised over \$5 Million dollars in 13 years to TACKLE ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE in the BIG D
 - For the first time, Fowler will be the recipient of \$10,000 from the proceeds of this game and we would like to have Fowler t-shirts in the crowd

 - Laura Porting will represent Fowler on the field during half time for the check presentation
- Yesterday, we were notified by the Communities Foundation of Texas that we have been awarded \$30,000 in grant money for Storm Relief
 - This money will go towards our \$100,000 insurance deductible on the damage we experienced from the winter storm
