- Good afternoon Fowler Family!
- COVID UPDATE:
  - As you have noticed, we are transitioning this time together from a COVID briefing to a community briefing
  - We will spend less time talking about COVID and more time sharing information about our community
  - This does not mean that COVID is gone or that we should not be cautious or mindful of our surroundings; it simply means we are in a 'living with it' phase
    - The numbers are actually going up again the latest variant is spreading quickly
    - The positivity rate is at 6.1%
    - We continue to encourage all unvaccinated people to become fully vaccinated
      - Which means as boosters become available, get them!
    - While the vaccine does not prevent COVID for everyone; it is credited with reducing the severity of symptoms and preventing death

## • FOWLER UPDATES:

- Our Accushield rollout is going smoothly
  - Accushield is a visitor management system that records all visitors who come and go from our buildings
  - It has replaced our manual COVID screening
  - All visitors should be signing in, getting a badge, and signing out this means vendors, volunteers, family members, hospice and home health aides and your personal aide
  - If you see someone without a visitor badge it means they did not sign in!
    - Please encourage them to go back and sign in
  - Team members: this is your required COVID screening, and it is essential that you utilize this system. When surveyors come to our building for annual survey they will pull the Accushield screening report and compare it to the staffing for the day to confirm everyone screened in
  - If you see a staff member without their badge, remind them to put it on
    - If you have misplaced your badge, you need to get a new one
  - Visitors MUST sign in and out
    - The system will record the comings and goings of all non-resident activity
- IF A NAME BADGE DOES NOT PRINT, contact your front desk for assistance. VISITORS MAY NOT ENTER WITHOUT A NAME BADGE
