- **Good afternoon, Fowler Family!**
- **COVID UPDATE:**
 - According to The Dallas-Fort Worth Hospital Council, the number of patients hospitalized with COVID19 in North Texas decreased by 137 over the weekend bringing the region's total number of hospitalizations to 3,985
 - Of those, 207 are at Parkland, down from 273 last Friday
 - While the drop in hospitalizations does not necessarily mean the omicron fueled surge in COVID hospitalizations has hit its peak, North Texas health care leaders are hopeful that the decrease will continue
 - Even patients admitted for other reasons, who then test positive for COVID, have an impact on our healthcare system because the hospitals must manage those individuals differently than a normal hospitalization – this too puts a strain on our healthcare system
 - While the positivity rate remains high at 37.5%, we remain focused on doing our part to reduce transmission and risk here at Fowler – thank you for wearing your mask and for your vigilance
- **FOWLER UPDATES:**
 - Here at Fowler, we continue to experience positive outcomes for residents and staff who test positive with COVID
 - 3 residents remain at a COVID skilled nursing community and are doing well – all are scheduled to return to Fowler by Friday!
 - All but one team member has returned to work; that team member returns tomorrow
 - We have some exciting announcements from The Ebby House
 - This past week, two of our Ebby House girls started college! This is a tremendous accomplishment
 - A new young lady will move into the Ebby House next Monday and we look forward to welcoming her
 - EH director Lisa Mumford shared this morning that she has stayed connected to one of our earliest residents. This young woman only lived with us for several months. She told Lisa today that she is now raising 2 young children as a single mother and has been at the same job for 2.5 years – “You would be proud of the woman I’ve become”
 - We don’t always know the impact we are making at the time – the work we do in the lives of our children and youth is transformational

- On Thursday, we will present in front of Crystal Charity Ball committee in hopes of receiving funding for our Youth Support Center – please keep those efforts in your prayers
- This morning, Chaplain Venessa sat for her ordination interview, and we are thrilled to share that she has been approved for ordination. More to follow on plans for ordination and of course a Fowler-sized celebration
- This week is Activity Professionals week – special thanks to Ann Garcia at FCA, Keyairria Hatton at Jackson Living Center and Jackie Means, Shranda Gowans and Tina Harris for their daily efforts to enrich lives
- We have expanded our partnership with Dr. Steven Bray and his PA, Chandra – they will begin seeing residents in Jackson Living Center
 - Dr. Bray is our medical director at PNCC.
 - He will bring a remote monitoring program to Jackson Living Center which will be helpful for residents with chronic conditions who would benefit from daily monitoring – such as diabetes, high blood pressure, etc.
 - The monitoring equipment is sent to the resident to use in their home and captures data that is sent to the doctor’s office daily. Significant changes can be detected so that they can intervene before something catastrophic happens.

 - Construction is on time – massive coordination of framing and plumbing has been successful; they are framing the third floor and roofing should begin in March!
