 - Abused and neglected children are 11 times more likely to engage in criminal behavior as an adult.
 - Child abuse occurs across all socioeconomic levels, ethnic and cultural lines, and religions and educational levels.
 - What are some ways **YOU** can observe National Child Abuse Prevention Month?
 - Wear **BLUE**, the official color of prevention, to show your support for children.
 - Encourage your children or the children living in your community to speak up if they have been mistreated.
 - Promote the prevention of child abuse through social media.
 - Volunteer to work for child abuse protection organizations.
 - Every child deserves a safe, stable, and nurturing environment that is free from abuse and neglect!
