• COVID UPDATE:

- Our COVID Booster Clinic was a success thank you to all who participated. If you

- We will have another booster clinic in 4-6 months so be on the lookout!

• FOWLER UPDATES:

- There is a planned power outage in FCA E Building on 5/31 overnight, 10pm-6am.
 Oncor will be burying the electrical wires for Eastside.
 - If all goes as planned, ONCOR will be on site and will go door-to-door FCA maintenance to shut down the power to each apartment between 8:30 pm 9:30 pm. The power inside your apartment will be down until 6 am Friday morning when ONCOR will go door-to -door with FCA Maintenance again to restore your power.
 - Generators will be running to provide power to the common areas and hallways throughout the night. So, those areas should have some lighting.
 - Please note that the elevator will also be out of service for the night too.
 - Keep your flashlights nearby and charge your cell phones/tablets/laptops/mobility devices to 100% prior to 10 pm Tuesday.
 - Please do not open your refrigerators if possible so that your food stays fresh
 - For those who require oxygen, the hallway outlets will be on generators so you can plug your machines in there if you do not have a portable machine.
 - We continue to do our best to make this process as seamless as possible for all; we appreciate your understanding as we continue to grow our community.
