#### DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION SHARED STORY

Why PRIDE? What is PRIDE month? Why is it so important? Many people in society today are very aware of what PRIDE month is and that celebrations, parades, and demonstrations will be held filled with many rainbow flags, bright colors, a ton of glitter, and outrageous outfits. But often people forget the purpose behind PRIDE month.

PRIDE month is a 30-day window of time each year when the queer community comes together in pursuit of freedom to live their lives and to fight for civil liberties that heterosexual persons have daily.

Living each day as an LGBTQ+ person has its very own set of struggles. Making a conscious decision to live outside of the box in society is a risky choice that LGBTQ+ people make daily. Choosing a hair style, where to work, what to wear, holding their significant others hand, even going to a public restroom. Any one of these can cause a person stress, can get a person verbally abused, and can lead an LGTBQ+ person into depression.

In society today:

- 43% of LGBTQ+ people have not revealed their true orientations at work.
- Only 46% of the LGBTQ+ community are open about their preferences to their family.
- 1 in 8 LGBTQ+ persons have experience discrimination from a healthcare professional leading many to avoid healthcare treatment all together.
- 54% of LGBTQ+ Americans have hidden their personal relationships to avoid discrimination.
- 29% of trans adults live in poverty
- In 2020 alone, the Human Rights Campaign announced that 44 trans people were killed in the US making that the deadliest year since 2013 when they began tracking the numbers.

These are only a few of the statistics just to give you a sense of what life is like for an LGBTQ+ person daily.

PRIDE month is so very important. PRIDE in being who you are, for honoring the accomplishments of the many activists before us that have paved the way for society today, and PRIDE in continuing the fight for equal treatment for all persons living in the LGBTQ+ community.

So, as PRIDE month comes to an end, please remember this, and honor all the lives lost along the way on the path to LGBTQ+ equal rights and inclusion.
