- **DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION SHARED STORY**
 - For nearly four decades, the country has recognized the month of October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. It is a month-long reminder devoted to educating society about breast cancer, and early detection.
 - Other than skin cancer, breast cancer is the most common type of cancer among American women. Mammograms are the best way to detect breast cancer, even in its early stages. By receiving your annual mammogram, doctors can find and treat, your cancer before it is large enough to feel or cause symptoms. Thus, providing you with a high possibility of survival.
 - Fast Facts About Breast Cancer
 - Each year in the United States, about 264,000 women get breast cancer and 42,000 women die from the disease.
 - Men also get breast cancer, but it is not very common. About 1 out of every 100 breast cancers diagnosed in the United States is found in a man.
 - Most breast cancers are found in women who are 50 years old or older, but breast cancer also affects younger women.
 - Please remember to perform your regular self-examinations, and to attend your annual mammogram screenings. When dealing with cancer, early detection your best defense.
