• FOWLER UPDATES:

- We are standing in the middle of a renovation area! We are thrilled to report that the chapel audio visual improvements are being installed over the next couple of weeks which will greatly improve your visual experience.
- Additionally, all the parking lots are being restriped! This is a multi-day process and we
 will send out notification to residents and staff on a daily basis through Voice Friend to
 notify you which parking lots will be off limits and where you can temporarily park. We
 appreciate your swift response to these messages as parking spaces cannot be striped
 if cars are in them!
 - Today they are striping the parking lots surrounding PNCC, FCA II and The Means Activity Center.
- We are excited to let you know Fowler has partnered with National Protective Service for an added layer of security services overnight. They will work 7 days a week from 11 pm until 7 am. We will still have our Courtesy Patrol viewing cameras from Jackson Living Center and responding to resident requests. Our new patrol officer will be wearing a uniform and patrolling on foot and in a mark security vehicle. The security vehicle will be on campus during the day as well, for additional deterrence.

- National Day of Tolerance
 - The call to practice tolerance was written into the identity of the United Nations some 70 years ago.
 - Every year on November 16th, the International Day for Tolerance generates awareness of the dangers of intolerance. Since the inception of this day, it's been the UN's goal to strengthen tolerance by fostering mutual understanding among cultures and people.
 - "Tolerance does not mean indifference or a grudging acceptance of others. It is a way of life-based on mutual understanding and respect for others, and on the belief that global diversity is to be embraced, not feared," stated UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon.
 - What do we do on Tolerance Day?
 - The International Day for Tolerance supports the notion that education is a key factor in preventing intolerance across humanity. On this day, we are encouraged to educate and learn how to practice solidarity between ethnic, social, and cultural groups.
 - Tolerance is defined as the ability or willingness to tolerate something, such as the existence of opinions or behavior that one does not necessarily agree with.
 - There is no doubt that a world free of tolerance would not be a good place. It is the belief of those supporting this day that such a world should of tolerance always exists. And everyone has a right to express religion without fear of bias or ridicule. In addition, it teaches that a person's racial or religious, or gender identity is inconsequential to the potential for tolerance and friendship.
 - This day was created to encourage mindfulness, faith in human rights, equality, and diversity worldwide.
